**This policy (and our website's terms of use) explains how any personal data we collect from you, or you provide to us, will be processed by the data controller — Meggitt PLC, Atlantic House, Aviation Park West, Bournemouth International Airport, Christchurch, Dorset, BH23 6EW.**

## Information from you

We may collect and process:

- information you provide by filling in forms on our site, www.meggitt.com. This includes information provided at the time of registering to use it, subscribing to and requesting services, posting material and reporting site problems;
- a record of correspondence with us;
- surveys you complete for us;
- details of transactions you carry out through our site and fulfilment of orders;
- details of your visits to our site including, but not limited to, traffic and location data and weblogs.

## IP addresses

We may collect information about your computer, including IP address, operating system and browser type for system administration. It does not identify any individual.

## Cookies

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users, helping us to improve our site and users' experience of it.

## Where we store your personal data

The data we collect from you may be transferred to, and stored at, a destination outside the European Economic Area ("EEA"). It may also be processed by staff operating outside the EEA who work for us or for one of our suppliers. All information you provide to us is stored on our secure servers. Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) a password which enables you to access certain parts of our site, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. The transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure. Although we will do our best to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee the security of data transmitted to our site; any transmission is at your own risk. Once we have received your information, we will use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorised access.

## Uses made of the information

We use information held about you to:

- ensure that content from our site is presented in the most effective manner for you and your computer;
- provide you with information, products or services that you request from us or which we feel may interest you, where you have consented to be contacted for such purposes;
- carry out our obligations arising from any contracts entered into between you and us;
- allow you to participate in interactive features of our service, when you choose to do so;
- notify you about changes to our service.

## Disclosure of your information

We may disclose your personal information to any member of our group, which means our subsidiaries, our ultimate holding company and its subsidiaries, as defined in section 1159 of the UK Companies Act 2006.

We may disclose your personal information to third parties:

- when we sell or buy any business or assets, in which case we may disclose your personal data to the prospective seller or buyer of such business or assets;
- if Meggitt PLC or substantially all its assets are acquired by a third party (personal data held by it about its customers will be one of the transferred assets);
- if we are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal obligation, or to enforce or apply our terms of use or terms and conditions of supply and other agreements; or to protect the rights, property, or safety of Meggitt PLC, our customers, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organisations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.

## Your rights

You have the right to ask us not to process your personal data for marketing purposes. We will usually inform you before collecting your data if we intend to use your data or disclose it to any third party for such purposes. You can exercise your right to prevent such processing by checking certain boxes on the forms we use to collect your data.
